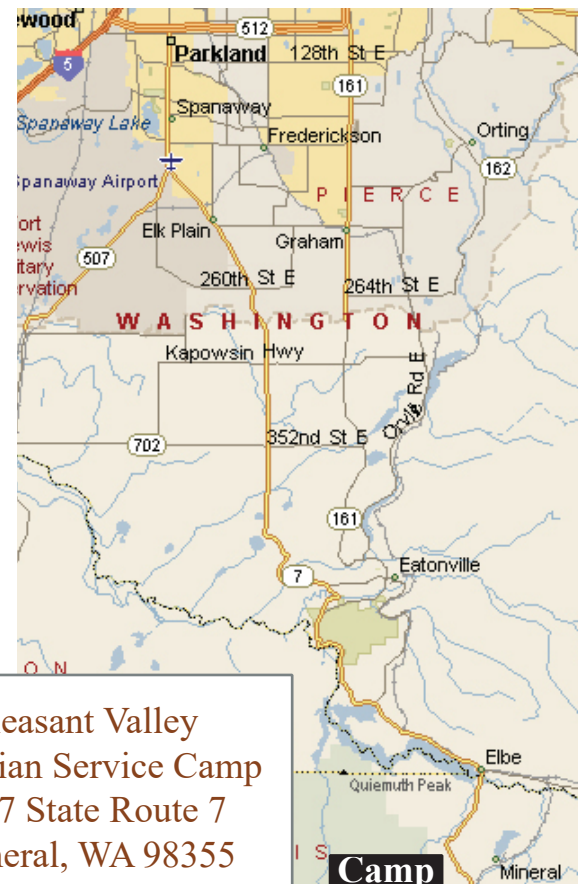
**BIBLE SCHOOL CAMP**

Follow the signs from this point

1. I-5 through Tacoma.
2. Take HWY 512 East toward Puyallup; EXIT 127.
3. Drive 2 miles and take the second exit: Turn right on Pacific Avenue to south.
4. Stay on Pacific for 5 miles until you reach the Roy "Y" looking intersection.
5. Keep left and stay on Hiway-7 for next 45 miles.
6. After crossing railroad tracks and a river bridge in Elbe keep going on Hiway-7 for another 4.5 miles and turn right on 74th RD.
7. Follow signs: "Pleasant Valley Christian Camp". Camp will be in a mile.

## CAMP ATTENDEES MUST:

- Be our church members or children of our church members.
- Obey administration, ushers, and leaders.
- Keep cabins and camp area in proper order.
- Return all lost items to the appropriate lost-and-found bin!
- Throw trash away in designated areas.
- Be safe for yourself and others!

## ITEMS TO BRING

- Bible, notebook, pen.
- Sleeping bag, blanket, and pillow.
- Personal Hygiene Items: (toothpaste, toothbrush, towels, shampoo/soap).
- Coat, sweater, jeans, socks, appropriate shorts, extra t-shirt and shorts for swimming.
- Extra socks and running shoes.
- Flashlights, mosquito spray.

## CAMP ATTENDEES CANNOT:

- Enter and/or leave camp grounds/field without prior notice and permit from the administration.
- Invite guests to the camp. Only ministers and parents are allowed to visit camp.
- Be elsewhere during church services.
- Harm the camp's properties, nature, and other people's belongings.
- Bring things for pranking or do pranking on camp.
- Wear inappropriate clothing. For example: All tops must have sleeves and modest neckline. No bare shoulders or waists. Shorts must be fingertip length or longer. During camp activities in between lunch and dinner, tank tops with thick sleeves are allowed. No spaghetti straps or muscle tank tops at any time. Tops and shorts must be worn over swimwear for females when swimming).
- Bring and wear jewelry.
- Bring players, computers, and other electronic equipment (cameras and cellphones OK).
- Sleep or sit in vehicles. Drive or even start up cars without prior arrangements with the administration.
- Make any kind of noise or disturb others after quiet time, which is from 12:00 to 8:00AM
- Bring and/or drink energy drinks, beverages containing alcohol, or any other enhancing fluids.
- Bring fireworks, matches/lighters, other explosive items, and weapons – open or concealed.
- Visit cabins of the opposite gender (except administration in case of emergency or disciplinary circumstances).
- Go out of the cabin after bed time is announced and until wake-up time at 8:00 AM.

**Violators of these rules will be sent home.**
